## LIVING LIFE IN ALL ITS FULLNESS

This week all clubs have started back up again. We are currently offering football (years 4,5,6), multi skills (years 3 and 4), Lego club (Year 2) and Choir (years 3,4,5,6). I have an overview of all clubs that we have already offered and will be offering in Spring 2 and the Summer term to ensure all year groups are being offered clubs. We have forest school, cooking, art and music coming up over the next term and a half. Currently, school pays for the football and multi skills club and school staff run all the other clubs in their own time, something of which I am very appreciative.

In addition to the various afterschool clubs, staff are using their own time to offer booster sessions to support your child with reading, writing or maths. If your child has been invited, can I please ask that you do your best to ensure they attend all sessions.

At St Margaret's at Hasbury, staff recognise that the teaching of English underpins a child's ability to access all areas of the curriculum through the development of fluent reading and an ability to organise and communicate their ideas effectively on paper. We would appreciate your support with our reading mission. Please can I ask that you spend 10-15 minutes every day reading with or to your child. This academic year has shown a significant decline in parental support for reading. Working together produces better outcomes for the children.
