

Dear Parents,

Friday's inset day was a successful day and I am pleased to say Google Classrooms is up and running. During this week children in years 3,4,5 and 6 will be practising to access their account in order to become familiar at accessing set work. Year 1 and year 2 also have a Google Classroom account but will require adult supervision to log on and navigate the site.

A letter that was sent out on the 3<sup>rd</sup> November asking any families who were unable to work remotely to contact the school office. School hasn't received any calls regarding this and therefore school will be setting work via Google Classrooms.

School has developed a quick guide to Google Classrooms and the information below explains what to expect from school if a bubble has to close or if school goes into a lockdown.

Circumstance	Learning
<p>Your child (and their siblings) is absent because they are awaiting test results/the household is required to self isolate.</p> <p>The rest of the school bubble are attending school and being taught as normal</p>	<p>All work will be uploaded onto Google Classroom.</p> <p><b>Maths</b> – White Rose will be uploaded onto Google Classrooms. This might be a combination of videos and powerpoints used in the classroom. Children will be sent home with an exercise book</p> <p><b>English</b> – reading (ebooks and activities), spelling, grammar, vocabulary.</p> <p><b>Phonics</b> – work set will be on the sounds your child will be missing.</p> <p><b>Curriculum</b> – follow the lessons being covered in class or Oak Academy units of work will be given. A subject per day will be provided. Science day one, History day two, etc.</p> <p><b>Collective Worship</b> x1 per week</p> <p><b>Picture News</b> x 1 per week</p>
<p>My child's whole bubble is not permitted to attend school because they, or another member of their bubble, have tested positive for Covid.</p> <p>We enter another 'lockdown' with school closure.</p>	<p>All work will be uploaded onto Google Classroom. Class teachers will be taking the register live at 9.00am in order to start your child's learning day off.</p> <p><b>Maths</b> – White Rose will be uploaded onto Google Classrooms. This might be a combination of videos and powerpoints. Children will be sent home with an exercise book.</p> <p><b>English</b> – Powerpoint with voice over or live lesson, If it is a live lesson with the class teacher your child will receive an invite on Google Classrooms. Reading (ebooks and activities), spelling, grammar, vocabulary.</p> <p><b>Phonics</b> – work set will be on the sounds your child will be missing.</p> <p><b>Curriculum</b> – follow the sequence of lesson as if children were in school or Oak Academy units of work will be given. A subject per day will be provided. Science day one, History day two, etc.</p> <p><b>Collective Worship</b> x1 per week</p> <p><b>Picture News</b> x 1 per week</p>
<p>All parents will be expected to engage in their child's learning by ensuring their child completes the work and the work is sent back to the class teacher using Google Classrooms.</p>
